Reminders!

We had a great Opening Day last week, thanks to everybody for making it wonderful! Here are a couple of things that came up that you should remember.

Info Booth: The Info Booth crew packs up and leaves at 5:30. The bell rings right around 5:15, so keep an ear out for that and hustle over to get your payment in before the crew heads out.

Load in/load out: Please pull all the way down on Oak St. to park along the Park Blocks, especially at the end of the day, so that other members can pull their vehicles in too and not be blocked or have to try to weave through stanchions/cones.

Shoplifting

New! Booth Weights Available, 4 for \$32

Until three weeks ago, it appeared that the Fire Marshal was going to require all booths at outdoor events to be weighted or tied down this season. To make it possible for Marketeers to comply in a very short time frame, we worked with Eugene Canvas to design and make many, many weight bags. Since then the City has decided to suspend this rule for now. In order to prepare for this eventual requirement and make the Market a safer place on windy days, Market Board and Management is working to craft rules for weighting of booths. You can get a copy of the proposed rules at the Info Booth if you are interested. The Board will discuss this at their next meeting. Talk to board members or plan to attend the meeting if you'd like to weigh in on this issue.

Now about those weights... they are locally made from heavy weight, water resistant, royal blue pack cloth. They have a 30 lb. capacity, and can be secured with a pin through the booth leg and a grommet, and have a buckled strap to wrap around the booth leg. Our Market Member Only special price for these is 4 for \$32. We will also sell individual bags for \$8 each. Cash or check only, as we are already selling them at a deep discount. These bags are available at the Info Booth or the office. They come with 4 pins for securing them to the booth legs. You can fill them at Lane Forest Products for about \$1.50.
