Remove Tape, Pretty Please

If you are in the same space for the entire show, help us out and pull your tape off the floor once you are sure you are in the right location. At the end of the Holiday Market, we are required to pull all the tape off of the floor and tape that has been in place for six weeks can be kind of hard to remove. Thanks for your help!

Important Parking Info

Park your vehicle in the parking lot behind the building. The front parking lot is for customers. Don't park in assigned handicapped spaces. Don't leave anything in your car, thefts happen.

Holiday Market Statements

Remember to pay your Saturday Market Fees!

The final Holiday Market statements went out in the mail. Your last payment is due by Dec. 15<sup>th</sup>. A \$5 late fee will be added per month to any outstanding Holiday Market balance.

Also, make sure you pay for any outstanding Saturday Market fees no later than **December 24<sup>th</sup>**. You must pay for all your Market days in order to receive your points for next year. This includes Wish List points, Waiting List points, and Holiday Market points for 2019.

Keep Calm & Carry Out

During the frenzy of loading out on Sundays, please be patient and courteous to your fellow marketers. Don't block loading zones and help others if you can. We all want to get home. Please be kind and polite.

Here Only This Weekend?

Remember to let your customers know if this is your only weekend selling, or if you are not coming back until the last three days. Many folks assume that everyone is here all the time and will come looking for you later, so capture those sales today!

Credit Card Transactions

We are pleased to provide the service of credit card transactions to facilitate your sales. We take Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover. There are full instruction and Visa slips for your use in the Member Services. Complete the form with your full first and last name, NOT your business name or your boothsitter's name. In order to assist your customer in getting back to your booth, we have color coded the slips to match your area of the room. Keep your slips each day to confirm that your check is correct. The checks for this weekend will be available in Member Services on Saturday, December 8<sup>th</sup>. If you are not selling next weekend, we will mail your checks to the address we have on file for you. Checks will be ready to pick up by Thursday, Dec 6<sup>th</sup>.

Beware of Counterfeit Money

We handle a lot of cash at Holiday Market. Right now, we don't have any reports of counterfeit money in our area; however, you should always be on the lookout for fake money. Here are some tips:

1. **Hold the bill up to the light.** Check for a holograph of the face on the bill plus the thin vertical strip containing the denomination. Also, make sure the watermark can be seen on both sides of the bill. There is a security thread imbedded from top to bottom on the face of the bill.

2. **Color-shifting ink:** If you hold the new series bill (except the \$5 note) and tilt it back and forth, please observe the numeral in the lower right hand corner as its color shifts from green to black and back.

3. **Comparison:** Test the feel and texture of the paper with other bills you know are authentic.

Feel free to ask your neighbors or come to Member Services if you are given a questionable bill.

Posters, Biz Cards, Guidebooks

Holiday Market posters, business cards and Guidebooks are all available in Member Services. Feel free to grab some and help spread the word. Include a HM business card with each purchase so folks who might receive your item as a gift know it's handcrafted!

Stock Must Be Removed

Remember that all stock must be removed from your booth by 8pm on Sunday night. If you are selling next weekend, your booth structure and furniture may stay.
