★ Group photo is scheduled for December 10th at 9:50 am in the food court. Whether you are selling that weekend or not, please plan on attending this as we want all members in the picture.

★ Kareng Fund is accepting donations at Vendor Services for its annual basket fundraiser held on December 24th at noon on the main stage. Please donate items you think would go nicely in a gift basket. This is a raffle and tickets will go on sale soon. You do not need to be present to win.

★ Kareng Fund is also accepting donations for its Pottery Smash fundraiser. Please drop donations at Vendors Services as well. More on the date and time it will be held.

Please do not begin load out on Sundays until 6 pm. It is part of our rules that vendors stay fully operational and available to sell until 6 pm. If you need to leave because of an emergency, please notify vendor services before you begin loading out. We understand emergencies happen, but it is bad for the market when vendors are leaving before 6 pm.

On Sundays, if you need help loading out at 6pm there is a list in Vendor Services that you can put your name on and we will assign crew to assist you. You will be helped in the order in which your name appears on the list.

Credit Card Transactions

We are pleased to provide the service of credit card transactions to facilitate your sales. We take Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover. There are full instruction and visa slips for your use in the Vendor Service Center. Complete the form with your full first and last name, NOT your business name or your boothsitter's name. In order to assist your customer in getting back to your booth, we have color coded the slips to match your area of the room.

Keep your slips each day to confirm that your check is correct. The checks for this weekend will be available in the office on Thursday, November 30th, or in Vendor Service Center on Saturday, December 2nd.

Stock Must Be Removed

Remember that all stock must be removed from your booth by 8 pm on Sunday night. If you are selling next weekend, your booth structure and furniture may stay.

Office/Market Schedule

The office will be open on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday next week from 10 am-4 pm. The Events Center will be open for set up from 12 pm-7 pm on Friday.

Here Only This Weekend?

Remember to let your customers know if this is your only weekend selling, or if you are not coming back until the last three days. Many folks assume that everyone is here all the time and will come looking for you later, so capture those sales today!

Postcards, Posters, Gift Guides

Holiday Market postcards, Holiday Market posters and Gift Guides are all available in the Vendor Service Center. Feel free to grab some and help spread the word. Put a poster up at your gym in the break room at work or your local coffee shop, leave a couple of guidebooks at your Doctor's office. Any place where you see lots of people is a great spot for a Holiday Market advertisement.

Tape Law

If you are in the same space for the entire show, help us out and pull your tape off the floor once you are sure you are in the right location. At the end of the Holiday Market, we are required to pull all the tape off of the floor and tape that has been in place for six weeks can be kind of hard to remove. Thanks for your help!

Blue Painter's Tape is the only form of tape to be used on Events Center surfaces. Please do not use any other form of tape on the walls or floors. If you need tape, it is available in Vendor Services.

Important Parking Info

Park your vehicle in the parking lot behind the building. The front parking lot is for customers. Don't leave anything in your car, as thefts do happen.

Holiday Market Tips

Electricity and the extension cord

Each booth has 500 watts of electric power. Only three pronged (grounded) extension cords are allowed to be used in the Holiday Market. As simple as this may seem, every year the fire marshal finds a few vendors that are still using the smaller 'zip cord' ungrounded type of cord. These are not permitted. Power strips are acceptable. Check Your Fire Extinguisher

Add this to your HM preparation list: make sure your fire extinguisher has a current tag. If not, now's a good time to get it updated before the fire inspection on Opening Day of Holiday Market. If you can't find your fire extinguisher, it's time to get a new one! The minimum size must be a U.L. classification 2A10BC.
