early can easily presume the whole Market is over and not even bother to come in and wander. Customers are disappointed, sales are lost.

Please, keep your booth up and stock available until our advertised closing time of 5 PM.

Holiday Market Renewal Cards Coming Soon!


Holiday Market renewal post cards will go into the mail next week. Booth Holders of Record will have until July 20 to reclaim their spaces. If you are a Booth Holder of Record and have a reason (shows, vacations, etc.) that you might miss the deadline, please let us know now. If you have lots of points but no reserve space, get your renewal in by July 20 so that you don't miss your chance to pick.

When you get your card, please double check the information on the label to make sure that your points, booth holder and membership status are accurate.

We require that you return the post card with an initial payment of \$225 for a Main Hall space, \$125 for a Holiday Hall, or \$100 if you have less than 15 Holiday Market points. Remember, Holiday Market points are different than Park Blocks points.
