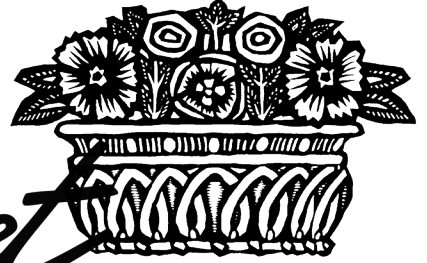

Booth Holder of Record Explained

Anyone can become a Booth Holder of Record (BHOR) at Holiday Market. Holiday Market points and BHOR status are completely dependent on your participation. You must have 31 points and sell in a Holiday Market space at least 4 weekends to be the BHOR of that space.

Points are made up from your membership points, 1/2 of your previous 2 years of Holiday Market attendance, all your Saturday Markets from the previous year, and the Saturday Markets in Oct. and Nov. of the year before that. Keep in mind that Holiday Market points are already determined at the beginning of the year.

If you would like to know where your points stand for the upcoming year, then you can ask for help in the office or the Info Booth.

New members are welcome at Holiday Market. Even though you haven't had a chance to gain Holiday Market points yet, there will be spaces for you. We use your Waiting List points from mid-September to book your space. You have plenty of time to attend Saturday Market in order to build up points for your first Holiday Market space booking. You may not get that super duper awesome corner space for your first year or you may not sell all weekends, but we always have room for the first weekend. We keep a waiting list for any full weekends.

Holiday Market renewal postcards go out in the mail on June 22nd. The online renewal form will be available on the 22nd too.
