Marketing for success at Saturday Market with Social Media

Many of us work with a limited budget, especially when it comes to marketing. This Social Media segment offers a variety of ways you can market your business without breaking the bank. Don't try to implement all of these strategies at once - trust me on that. Just choose one and give it a good effort. Don't be embarrassed or afraid to ask for help. Read the helpful information available to you. Get comfortable with working your marketing choice, and see what happens. Once you're feeling pretty good about it, add another social media strategy to the mix.

•FaceBook - Create a Page for your business and invite your friends and family to "Like" it and share it with their friends. Create an event in your Page each time you set up to vend, regardless where it is. I created a map that I include in my events to help customers find me at booth #177 at market.

•Instagram - If you don't have an Instagram account, why not set one up. This media is specifically for use with your smartphone or iPad or Tablet. Post pictures and brief descriptions on the fly. So easy to do while you're set up at market or while making product at home. Follow others you think might be interested in your products. Sometimes they will follow you back. That's a good thing.

•A Newsletter - If you have a list of emails from your customers, leverage that warm contact information by publishing a newsletter, weekly, monthly, whatever makes sense for your business. Don't have email addresses from your customers? Time to start asking for them so you can keep in touch. How? When a customer makes a purchase, offer them the opportunity of signing up for your newsletter. Have a form ready so it's quick and easy for them to sign up. A few free newsletter builder sites I've used are www.constantcontact.com. Check them out and see if writing a newsletter is for you.

•Blog/Vlog -https://www.blogger.com/about/

You can begin blogging about your business using Google's Blogger. You'll need to establish a Gmail account, www.gmail.com, if you don't already have one. But after that you're free to write as often as you like, upload photos, etc. You can share a link to your blog on any of your social media accounts and invite friends to check it out. Record your own video talking about something your customers might find interesting and upload it to your blog.
