Maybe it is the joy I get when watching my daughter say her wedding vows wearing the jewelry that I made just for her and that special occasion. Maybe it is knowing I might have helped a woman just leaving Willamette Family Treatment Center by giving her earrings to wear for a job interview, making her feel more confident or special. Maybe I do it, maybe we all do it, because it is an extension and expression of who we are.

If you have not turned in your application, you can still do so! Stop by the info booth or head to the Saturday Market website. You can still apply online at our website!

Members with 0 Points: Even if you have just started at Market, you can sell at Holiday Market. You will be able to get a space on the first weekend, and possibly other weekends! Turn in an application, and know it will be September before we get to your application.

Deposit: We require that you secure your space with an initial payment of \$225 for a Main Hall space, \$125 for a Holiday Hall, or \$100 if you have less than 15 Holiday Market points. WE DEPOSIT ALL HOLIDAY MARKET CHECKS AND CHARGE CARDS RIGHT AWAY. Make arrangements with AJ if you need to give us a smaller deposit to start.

Remembering Judy Anderson 11/11/1948-7/31/2018

Judy Anderson, maker of 'Judy-Judy Bags' was a long time member of Saturday Market. You never knew what new, creative, whimsical pieces she would put together from her incredible collection of fabrics, trims, buttons and machines. Tote bags, fanny packs change pouches, costumes, clothing and hair bling all with her unmistakable touch. Her wicked sense of humor, often reflected in her works, could turn any Saturday into a laugh filled one. She was always willing and ready to share her sewing knowledge and library with anyone who needed it. Judy did a lot for Market, one big project was when Holiday Market was moved and consolidated to where we are now. She took the ideas generated by the committee and utilizing her drafting skills was instrumental in creating the original layout we used.

Judy had a deep and abiding love of rescue dogs, at one point she and Craig had five rescues living with them. It could be said that her last dog, Freya, was her favorite but don't tell the others.

About eleven years ago Judy received the life saving gift of a liver transplant, she was ever thankful to the donor and the doctor who was tenacious in getting her on the transplant list. Judy would want you to know that it is easy to get on the organ donor list. The miracle liver kept her going for years, allowing her to see her granddaughters grow up and spending more time with those she loved. The last couple years were a struggle with various health issues, she tried to meet those issues but in the end she passed on her own terms departing early in the morning of July 31st with Craig by her side.

She is survived by her husband and life partner Craig Anderson, daughter Sky Hanson, granddaughters Emily and Alyssa, niece Grace and beloved friends far and wide. She will be deeply missed and fondly remembered.
