Good Morning Holiday Marketers! Welcome to the final weekend of the 2019 Holiday Market!

Lots of fun things are happening this weekend – we have the Kareng Fund Pottery Smash on Sunday, December 22nd at 8:30 a.m. and the raffle drawing on Tuesday, December 24th at 12 p.m. Be sure to come early on Sunday and get those raffle tickets turned in by noon on Tuesday.

We are still in need of volunteers on December 26th for takedown. Please signup for a 2 hour shift. Your efforts are appreciated by all.

As you know, we close at 4 p.m. on Sunday, December 24th. This will be a busy load-out and I ask that you adhere to some specific guidelines:

- 1. Don't close early
- 2. Pack up your booth, then get your car
- 3. Pull up any tape around your booth
- 4. Do not leave your car idling in the loading zone
- 5. Be kind and don't park in the loading zone for more than 20 minutes
- 6. Share the carts. Wait to get a cart until you are ready to take a load to your car and return it promptly.

You can also load-out on Tuesday, December 26th from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m. Be sure to take all of your stock with you on December 24th.

The Market Offices will be closed December 25th through January 1st, 2020. We will have office hours January 2nd – 3rd, 2020, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. Then we will be closed through February 4th, 2020, except for scheduled Board and Committee meetings. 
Holiday Market Payment Reminder
