Good Morning Holiday Marketers!  
Welcome to the final weekend of the 2019 Holiday Market!

Lots of fun things are happening this weekend – we have the Kareng Fund Pottery Smash on Sunday, December 22<sup>nd</sup> at 8:30 a.m. and the raffle drawing on Tuesday, December 24<sup>th</sup> at 12 p.m. Be sure to come early on Sunday and get those raffle tickets turned in by noon on Tuesday.

We are still in need of volunteers on December 26<sup>th</sup> for takedown. Please sign-up for a 2 hour shift. Your efforts are appreciated by all.

As you know, we close at 4 p.m. on Sunday, December 24<sup>th</sup>. This will be a busy load-out and I ask that you adhere to some specific guidelines:

1. Don't close early
2. Pack up your booth, then get your car
3. Pull up any tape around your booth
4. Do not leave your car idling in the loading zone
5. Be kind and don't park in the loading zone for more than 20 minutes
6. Share the carts. Wait to get a cart until you are ready to take a load to your car and return it promptly.

You can also load-out on Tuesday, December 26<sup>th</sup> from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m. Be sure to take all of your stock with you on December 24<sup>th</sup>.

The Market Offices will be closed December 25<sup>th</sup> through January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. We will have office hours January 2<sup>nd</sup>– 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. Then we will be closed through February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020, except for scheduled Board and Committee meetings. All Visa checks will be mailed December 26<sup>th</sup>. Please make sure we have a good mailing address for you if you are using the Visa services at the information booth.

## Office Schedule, Important Dates & Closing Reminders

We have had a great Holiday Market. As we finish this weekend, remember these important dates and tips:

- Dec. 24<sup>th</sup>: We will close the market at 4pm, and the building will close at 8pm. Please remove your stock and as much of your booth as possible.
- Dec. 26<sup>th</sup>: The building is open from 10am-3pm. You must have your entire structure and furnishings removed by 3pm. If any part of your booth is still standing at 2pm, then we will remove it and store it until you can collect it at the office. A storage fee will be applied to any structures left behind.
- Dec. 27<sup>th</sup>-Jan. 1<sup>st</sup>: Office is closed.
- Jan. 2<sup>nd</sup>-Jan. 3<sup>rd</sup>: The Saturday Market office is open from 10am-4pm.
- Jan. 4<sup>th</sup>-Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup>: Office closed. We will be open Tuesday-Friday from 10am-4pm starting Feb. 4<sup>th</sup>.
- Feb. 15<sup>th</sup>: Membership renewal begins. make sure you pay your \$50 fee along with your application to renew and go on the Wish List for a reserve space.
- March 1<sup>st</sup>: Deadline for Reserve Members to renew their membership and claim their park blocks reserve space.
- April 4<sup>th</sup>: Our 51<sup>st</sup> Saturday Market season begins!

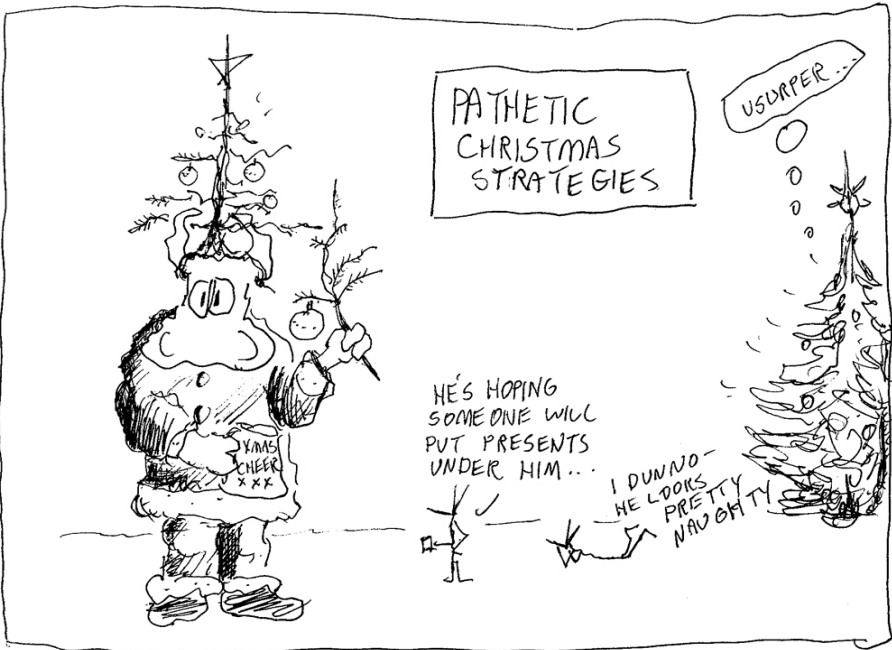
## Holiday Market Payment Reminder
