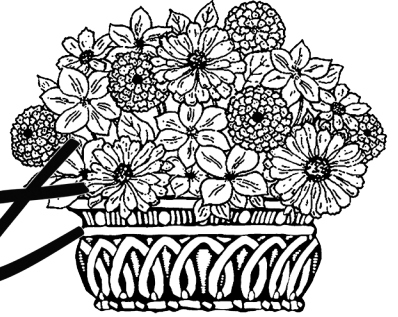

50th Season Library Display

The 50th Season display has been installed in the Eugene Public Library. The display will be in place until December 28th. It looks amazing! Please go by the library and check it out. It's on the 2nd floor in the newspaper and magazine reading room.

Holiday Market Tips

Electricity and the extension cord:
 Each booth has 500 watts of electric power. Only three pronged (grounded) extension cords are allowed to be used in the Holiday Market. We will be walking around checking on your electrical cords every Friday. As simple as this may seem, every year the fire marshal finds a few members that are still using the smaller 'zip cord' ungrounded type of cord. These are not permitted. Power strips are acceptable. Please make the investment in grounded cords and watch the wattage on light bulbs. Make sure you unplug and turn off all lights when you leave. Check Your Fire Extinguisher
 Add this to your HM preparation list: make sure your fire extinguisher has a current tag. If not, now's a good time to get it updated before the fire inspection on Opening Day of Holiday Market. If you can't find your fire extinguisher, it's time to get a new one! The minimum size must be a U.L. classification 2A10BC.

Holiday Market Booth Partners

Booth Partners at Holiday Market require a Booth Share form. You can only share your booth with a current Saturday Market member. Both members must sign the form. Get those forms in ASAP! If we don't have the Booth Share form, then your booth partner will not be added to the census, they won't be on the website, they won't be in the directory AND they will not receive any points. Don't wait until we are setting up since all the work will be finished by then. Booth Share forms are available at the Info Booth and in the office. Even if you told someone that you are sharing, you must fill out the form to be in the census and get those points.

Holiday Market Disabled Parking

JJ will have disabled parking permits for those who contacted her previously. Those permits will be available for pickup on Friday, Nov. 15th in Membership Services (setup day). Please contact JJ if you need a disabled parking permit for Holiday Market. There are still available spaces.

Important Dates Coming Up

Office Schedule:

The office will be closed Nov. 12th. We will be open on Wednesday Nov. 13th. Visa checks from the last Saturday Market will be ready to pick up by 3pm on Wednesday. Any checks that aren't picked up will be mailed. The office will be closed on Thursday, Nov. 14th. Membership Services opens at 11am on Friday, Nov. 15th.

During Holiday Market, the regular office hours are Wed.-Fri., 10am-4pm. Membership Services is open on Holiday Market days from 8:30am-7pm. We conduct normal office business in Membership Services. The phone number to Membership Services is 541-686-8885. All Visa checks can be picked up in Membership Services. Any checks not picked up will be mailed the following week.

The office will be closed on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 28th. We will be open in Membership Services on Friday, Nov. 29th.

The office will be closed on Wed. Dec. 18th.

Take Down and Set Up for Final Weekend

If you are selling on Saturday and Sunday only, Dec. 21st-Dec. 22nd, you must remove your entire booth by 9 p.m. on December 22nd.

If you are selling on Monday and Tuesday only, Dec. 23rd-Dec. 24th, you can set-up your booth at 7:00 a.m. on December 23rd.

Sustainability Zone

MICRO-GARBAGE: It is everywhere and yet its rarely seen due to its tiny size. Micro-garbage includes cigarette butts, zip ties, shards of plastic cup lids, the corners off your protein bar wrappers, and the smallest are glitter, microabrasion pellets, old plastic that's fragile and breaks into hundreds of pieces... the list is long.

At SATURDAY MARKET when you dispose of your booth garbage at the end of the day, PLEASE put your smaller micro-garbage inside a bag or cup that's also going into the garbage. 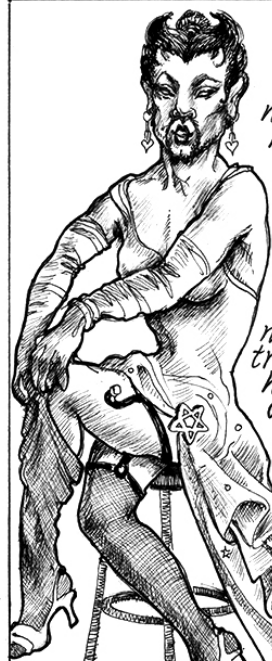
