Next Friday during Holiday Market set up, we hope you'll take a break and share a meal with your fellow marketers and staff. Snacks and finger foods will be provided. We hope you'll bring a dish to share as well. We sit down to eat at 6pm. You can go back to setting up after taking this nice little breather.

Extreme Weather Policy

Our practice has been, that if you come down and sell, but later begin to suffer ill-effects from the weather and staying would compromise your health, you are permitted to pack up and leave early. Please inform your neighbors and the staff at the information booth of your need to leave and minimize disruption to Market as you make your way out. We understand that the threshold for extreme weather intolerance isn't the same for everyone. As a business owner, it is your right and responsibility to protect yourself and employ-ees from harm. The important thing is that

you came down to make a Market. This policy also applies to your safety. If you feel that it is unsafe to stay at market, you are permitted to pack up and leave early. This is a common concern after daylight savings time takes effect and it is dark before 5pm. Please follow the procedure outlined above if you feel the need to leave early due to safety reasons.

The Market office is moving over to the fairgrounds this week. We are adjusting the schedule to match Holiday Market hours

Visa checks from today's Market will be ready on Wednesday. You can pick up your check before 3pm or it will go in the mail.

- •Food Court set up is Thursday.
- •Member Services at the Events Center is open on Friday at 11am.
- •Craft members set up on Friday from NOON to 9 PM.
- •The Harvest Snack Luck is on Friday at 6 PM in the food court area.
- •The building opens for Members at 7 AM on Saturdays and 8 AM on Sundays.
- •The Market opens for business at 10 AM and is open until 6 PM on Saturday and Sunday.
- •The Building Closes at 9 PM on Sundays. All stock must be taken out. You can leave your booth and decorations in place if you are staying in the same space for the next weekend. If you are moving to a new space, then you must take your entire booth.
- •Dec. 22nd Take Down must be complet-
- ed by 9 PM.
 •Dec. 23rd Set Up: The building opens at 7 AM. You must be ready by 10 AM.

During Holiday Market, our office hours are Wed-Fri from 10am-4pm. Member Services will be open on Holiday Market days from 8:30am-7pm.

Our office will be closed on Thanksgiving day and on Christmas day. We will mail all Visa checks from the last weekend on Dec. 26th. After Holiday Market is over and put away, the office will be closed until February 4th,


