No doubt you've noticed that we have new trash cans at the Market this season. Gone are the old wire racks that required frequent replacing and too many plastic bags. Everything but bottles and cans (and utensils, of course) now goes into a single receptacle, but every bit is still sorted by our intrepid recycling team, David Diercks and Chris Kritch. With that in mind, here are a few things that can make their job easier:

Bring Your Own Mug! Every drink you buy in your own cup keeps a plastic or paper one out of the landfill. That adds up to a lot in one season. And some vendors offer discounts when you bring your own!

•Bring a cloth napkin. Rexius is no longer composting paper and they have to be

Do you REALLY need that straw?

•Pack it in, pack it out. It would be helpful to our crew if they didn't have to sort through extra garbage, especially mi-cro-trash. Things such as fishing line, zip ties and sampling spoons can make sorting much more difficult. If you must toss them here, please contain them in something else that is to be (or has been) thrown away.
•Try reusable Velcro zip ties instead.

They can be found at hardware stores like Jerry's and, of course, online. And you only have to buy them once!

•Let's talk about glitter. Most of it by far is made from Mylar (using, among other things, polyethylene terephthalate aka plastic). Yes it's pretty, but please keep in mind that glitter+compostables=garbage. Please don't mix it in with the trash! Better yet, check out BioGlitter by Eco Glitter Fun.

Reminders about booking:

1. Make sure we have current contact information on file for you including a daytime phone number and an email address. When you receive your call from AJ to book your space, you must respond quickly.

2. We call members using Holiday Market points to assign spaces. We will have updates on the booking process, including what points we are booking, in the newsletter every week up until we run out of spaces. Keep an eye on those updates so you know when to expect your call based on your Holiday Market points.

3. When making a Holiday Market payment at the Info Booth, please ask for a receipt. We depend on your receipts if there is an issue with your payment history.


