Office Schedule:

The office will be closed Tuesday, Nov. 16th. We will be open on Wednesday Nov. 17th. Visa checks from the last Saturday Market will be ready to pick up by 3pm on Wednesday. Any checks that aren't picked up will be mailed. The office will be closed on Thursday, Nov. 18th. Membership Services opens at 11am on Friday, Nov. 19t

During Holiday Market, the regular office hours are Wed.-Fri., 10am-4pm. Membership Services is open on Holiday Market days from 8:30am-7pm. We conduct normal office business in Membership Services. The phone number to Membership Services is 541-686-8885. All Visa checks can be picked up in Membership Services. Any checks not picked up will be mailed the following week.

The office will be closed on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 25th. We will be open in Membership Services on Friday, Nov. 27th.

Take Down and Set Up for Final Selling Days

If you are selling on Saturday and Sunday, Dec. 18th-Dec. 19th, you must remove your entire booth by 9 p.m. on December 19th.

If you are selling on Thursday and Friday,

Dec. 23rd-Dec. 24th, you can set-up your booth at 7:00 a.m. on Dec. 23rd. You can choose to take down your booth on Dec. 24th or come back on Monday Dec. 27th. Everything must be removed from the LEC by 3pm on Monday, Dec. 27th. Anything left behind will be put in storage and assessed a fee.

Holiday Market Alter-Abled Parking

JJ will have alter-abled parking permits for those who contacted her previously. Those permits will be available for pickup on Friday, Nov. 19th in Membership Services (setup day). Please contact JJ if you need an alter-abled parking permit for Holiday Market. There are still available spaces.

Reminder: Alter-abled parking at Holiday Market is by permit only. Please do not park in a alter-abled spot for any amount of time. It's inconsiderate to those that need those spaces for ease of access to the building.

Reminders about booking:

- 1. Make sure we have current contact information on file for you including a daytime phone number and an email address. When you receive your call from AJ to book your space, you must respond quickly.
- 2. We will have updates on the booking process, including what points we are booking, in the newsletter every week up until we run out of spaces. Keep an eye on those updates so you know when to expect your call based on your Holiday Market points.
- 3. When making a Holiday Market payment at the Info Booth, please ask for a receipt. We depend on your receipts if there is an issue with your payment history
- 4. Pick up a map and keep it handy. We have maps on the website here: https:// tinyurl.com/pvvs62cp. When you get the call to book your space, you will need the map to help guide your decision.
