Saturday Market Board of Directors Election

Official Ballot, December 5th, 2020

The election is held on December 5th, 2020. Only current Members of Saturday Market are eligible to vote. The member is the name listed on the membership roster. Additional individuals on a membership are family members or business partners and are not eligible to vote unless they also have a membership in their name. Membership status will be verified.

There are three positions open on the Board of Directors, each has a term of eighteen months. Ballots must be received at the Market Office or at the Information Booth by 3:30 pm on December 5th, 2020, to be counted.

Vote for THREE by placing an "X" in the appropriate boxes on the ballot. (Do not vote for more than three candidates or the ballot will be void.)

Write your name LEGIBLY on the envelope provided, not your business name, (available next to the ballot box), and place the ballot in the envelope or the ballot will be void.
