



What a great opening weekend we had! This weekend should feel like a continuation of our Grand Opening this season because we are extending the elf game. So be sure to interact with the children excited to find all the elves!

The Board elections will take place on December 7th and 8th, 2024. A few tidbits of information to tell your customers and neighbors:

- 1. There are new water fountains and water bottle stations in the lobby! Water is also available in the vending machines in the lobby as well. Food Court does not sell or provide water.

- 3. We also are a donation site for Food for Lane County www.foodforlanecounty.org. My goal this year is to fill 9 barrels of food for donation. That is 1 ½ barrels per block! I think this is a manageable goal, so Food for Lane County sent us 10 barrels. I believe that sounds like a challenge! But seriously, many of our neighbors and friends in our community are hungry during the Holidays. Peanut butter, tuna, canned vegetables, canned stews, soups and chili are on the "most needed" list of donations.
- 4. Part of our Sustainability Program this year was to include non-disposable plates to the Holiday Market and eventually to the Saturday Market. Encourage one another to reduce, reuse and recycle and support the food vendors that are utilizing this durable program.

Now, gentle reminders: Open hours are from 10:00 am – 6:00 pm, please refrain from packing up your booth to leave at 6:00 pm. ALL products must be removed from your booth on Sunday evening load out. Your booth and decorations can remain, but please NO products. Now, please take a deep breath and remember how incredibly blessed we all are to be here, a part of this wonderful community and among talented friends who inspire and support us everyday. 
The Kareng Fund Needs Your Help!

The Kareng Fund provides a safety net for low-income artisans in crisis. In the 20 years since we organized, we have given grants to over 200 crafters and the total given is over \$125,000.00. All of that help came from the generosity of our community. We established as an independent 501c3 Nonprofit in 2014 and cash donations are fully deductible. At Holiday Market we have two major fundraisers, the Basket Raffle (Tuesday, December 24th) and the Pottery Smash Auction (Sunday December 15th at 8:30 am.) Please drop off your donations for the five baskets, just inside the member services office. You may also bring your pottery (seconds are fine for this), where it will be sorted prior to the auction. We will also accept craft items for the planned Art Bingo and Silent Auction which will reappear in the Spring.

You are eligible to win baskets and you can buy tickets at the little booth near the Food Court for \$5.00 each or 5 for \$20.00. There is a QR Code so you can do it quickly and easily. If you have time to volunteer, we can use help selling tickets as well as running the auction on the 15th. If you have not attended, please come! With a "Golden Ticket" your guests will be able to get into the building and are also welcome to participate in the Pottery Smash.

It is very heart-warming to share that time with each other and help build community and help those who need it. You never know when it could be you who needs a hand and we're all stronger together.
