This year there has been a lot of discussion between the Holiday Market Committee, Budget Committee and Board regarding how we can create equity for all booths spaces. Along with a flat fee increase this year, your Board decided to implement the same square footage rate for both halls and all booth spaces. For example, if you have an 8x8 booth in Evergreen Hall, your booth fee will increase a total of \$59 if you sign up for all seven selling blocks. You will see this increase on your postcards.

The equity discussion then turned to booth spaces that benefit from having more than one frontage space (booths with two or three selling sides). It is common practice that art festivals sell these spaces at a premium, because they allow the booth holder to make more money and many of us have enjoyed this additional space, at the same price as our single frontage neighbors. The Board approved an additional charge for booths with two or three frontage spaces, and you will see the new pricing on the postcards.
