Soon - In June, we choose from willing candidates, and they need to submit their statement and photo no later than May 21st. You must have also attended a Board meeting in the past year, if you have not attended a meeting this year, but still have an interest in running for the Board, you can attend the next B.O.D. meeting on June 4th. As an observation of strong boards, may I fuel enthusiasm with a list of qualities?

- 1) Clarity An ability to hear many opinions and then sort out solutions. With the strength of new ideas brought forward. From listening carefully to the opinions shared, a person with clarity can creatively find and suggest directions to take.
- 2) Patience To understand that not everyone fits into a single category. Change will need to be thought through, discussed and calculated to meet the needs of many. Ideally, by being patient improvements can be made without creating new problems to solve.
- 3) Mediator type / A grounded presence. When representing your voice as a director, you speak for our membership. Sometimes, it is good to not have preconceived viewpoints. To be focused and hold concern for a long term outcome, while greeting each individual issue with deep thinking and an open mind. "Stay calm and carry on.
- 4) A unifier This aspect is in regard to how groups function. A tendency to become divided usually has a grievance which unites a sub-group. If a person is capable, they can address aired failings while creating a strengthened alliance of the entire group. That happens when each standing member of the B.O.D. is able to hear the concerns of the membership and participate as a director of a unified group. Of course, there is discussion and a diversity of views, but with a common goal to keep our Saturday Market as healthy, whole and welcoming as possible our board can solve problems and find positive direction.

Our change is inevitable. Let it be good changes! I encourage members to consider this as they decide to be a candidate to serve on our Board.
