

Greetings Artisans,

Here we are in May already! We were incredibly blessed with terrific weather during April! Here are some stats for April 2025: Our gross profit was 32.3% higher than last year, and our net income was 201% higher than last year (I believe the nice, sunny weather helped!). For the whole month the average Craft reported 10% was \$26.21 and the International Food Court average reported 10% came in at \$149.93!

This month should be rather exciting with the Mother's Day Giveaway and Founders Day Market. We may still have various protests in the area, but so far they have been cooperative (never including the Wellsprings Group).

It is once again time to send in your proposals for this year's Holiday Market poster/guidebook cover. You can pick up a Call to Artists for at the Info Booth or office. To be considered for this opportunity, you just need to submit three things: one proposal sketch (that shows your proposed idea/direction for the poster), a filled out Call to Artists form, and 5-8 pictures of previously completed work.

Any currently enrolled member, folks a part of your single economic unit (ex: your children, roommates, or family living with you), and employees of food booths in the International Food Court are eligible to submit. Please turn in submissions by 11:59 PM on May 28th. If selected, you will have until 11:59 PM on August 26, 2025 to complete your proposed design/project, and you will be awarded a free full page on the inside cover of this year's guidebook.
