#### Elections

The Board of Directors election held on June 14th, 2025 (counted June 16th, 2025), had a total of 249 votes, 244 of which were deemed valid. Here are the tally results of the election:

- 18-month terms will be filled by Amanda Finegold - 169, Haven Sundstrom - 167, and Douglas Robertson - 162.
- •12-month terms will be filled by Sue Theolass - 153 and Kyle Reallon - 150.
- 6-month term will be filled by Catherine Heisine - 140.
