## From the Office: Storytime

Greetings Artisans!

I would like to tell you little story about last weekend and our "favorite" Protestor group, Reformed Baptist Church of Doug-

Saturday began early with the Pride Parade gathering at Kesey Square. The square was glistening with festive colors, smiling faces, and brightly colored flags proudly fluttering in the morning's soft summer breeze. Just beyond the warm murmuring of greetings and squeals of tuning instruments was the amplified words of "Pastor" Mason preaching hellfire and damnation. I told our staff that the Roseburg group was here in Eugene and to prepare for a possible visit. We alerted our neighbors, Farmer's Market and the Free People's Plaza, to deploy our "Operation Debris." Saturday Market filled the public spaces on the 2 southern corners of 8th and Oak and the FM and Free People's filled their spaces with debris: street signs, carts, garbage cans, tables, and bubble machines. I also spoke to EPD.

The Protestors arrived after opening, after the Pride Parade marched past the Market and found they had a small public space down from the corner on the Free People's Plaza side to set up. They began to sermonize and shake their posters at passersby. It was not long before there was a confrontation and violent outburst. Posters were shredded, a megaphone was taken, the crowd began shoving and fists began to fly. I called our EPD contact (not 911), and within minutes EPD was on the scene. The result? Four arrests: 2 Free People's Plaza members, one community member and -DRUMROLL PLEASE- Pastor Ryan Clark!

It is the small victories that give me such great satisfaction. Now, for Market news...

Our "Spaz" (Member Liaison) is no longer working for our organization. He will always be a part of our Saturday Market family, and we wish him the very best on his journey.

Financial Update: For the month of June our crafter 10% average was \$25.31 and median \$18.50. Food Court average for June was \$120.98. After the booth fee increase that started on June 28th, we brought in an additional \$1020.00 in revenue. What an incredible start!
