Town Hall

Last Thursday we had our Town Hall meeting. Attendance was low but the questions and discussion were great! Topics covered included ESM financials and the future, our emerging Governance Committee, and of course Holiday Market 2025. As with the last Town Hall Meeting, a summary will be available by the end of the month.

A cost analysis of the increased expenses of Market was presented and showed an increase from 2023-2024 of \$52,747.13. These are hard costs such as rent, storage, Insurance, toilets, security, permits, and more. Over the past 4 years (since COVID) our SM income has increased by 43% whereas our expenses have increased by 85%. We are currently looking at various ways to add/improve income streams. We have significantly cut costs temporarily in staffing and advertising. This is not a solution, but a quick fix. We will need a solid staff team and robust advertising budget if we want to see increased revenue for all.

Maia Bowers gave a lovely introductory speech about the Governance Committee and announced the first scheduled meeting Thursday 9/18/25 at 5:00pm.

Holiday Market 2025 is mostly booked (go Sonia go) and we are excited to announce that the new Holiday Market poster will be available this week! Also, we will be the centerfold spread in Eugene Weekly's "Things to do in Winter" edition. This Holiday Market is shaping up beautifully.
