**From Willy**We are in challenging times. From the national scene, to right here at Saturday Market. As an old time market artisan, it saddens me to see the amount of vitriol exhibited by members, old and new. I have noticed there are many more complaints now than ever before. Some well founded, some not so much. When confronted by a problem, or situation, I find it helpful to gather information, and try to go to the source, and begin to find a solution. At our Market, that usually means joining a committee to make my ideas heard, and perhaps affect change. I do not always succeed.

There appears to be members who complain, often with legitimate concerns, who feel that complaining is enough, and 'others will act on their complaints. I have found one of the best ways to effectively make a change, is to begin to offer solutions. That does not mean denigrating, or insulting other members, staff, or the public. It means attending meetings, and raising the con-cerns one has, and offering the solutions to the group. Yet, keep in mind, that your problem, and solution, may not be what the group wants.

As a member driven organization, it sometimes takes a considerable amount of time to identify a problem, a solution, and find enough support among the members to effect that solution. Above all, being aware of how this works will affect how you are perceived, and will affect how your issue will be resolved. For over fifty years, we have come together and collectively found solutions for our issues, even during the most challenging times.

### Beware of Fake Funds!

We handle a lot of cash at Saturday Market. Unfortunately, counterfiet bills at last week's Market are not uncommon. Here are some tips for identifying counterfiet bills:

1. Hold the bill up to the light. Check for a holograph of the face on the bill plus the thin vertical strip (which is also visable with a UV flashlight) containing the denomination. Also, make sure the watermark can be seen on both sides of the bill. There is a security thread embedded from top to bottom on the face of the bill.

2. Color-shifting ink: If you hold the new series bill (except the \$5 note) and tilt it back and forth, please observe the numeral in the lower right hand corner as its color shifts from green to black and back.

3. Comparison: Test the feel and texture of the paper with other bills you know are

Feel free to ask your neighbors or come to the South Park Info Booth if you are given a questionable bill. We have pens for checking available at the Info Booth.

Remember, you must pay for your Market day by Wednesday to get your point in time for the next Saturday. Also remember that after 30 days a \$5 late fee is added to your owing, and after 60 days another \$5 fee is added for a total of \$10.


