

# Board Election December 13

It's that time again! It's not even Halloween yet, but it's time to consider running for the board.

Saturday Market's board has 9 members. Elections are held every six months in June and December, for 18-month terms. The terms are staggered, so there are 3 positions open each election.

Anyone who runs for the board has to attend at least one board meeting to be eligible. There is one more opportunity, November 5. We usually do not have a regular board meeting in December, because we have the Annual Meeting instead.

Meetings are held the first Wednesday of every month at 5:15. We meet upstairs in the building where our office is. It's not easy to find, so be sure to ask for directions if you haven't been to the office before. You can also attend on Zoom to become eligible, but you will get a much better feel for what it's like if you attend in person. Loading/Unloading

You may not know about our loading/unloading policy.

Vehicles can be unloaded/loaded on East, West, and South Park Streets, and on 8th and Oak Streets before 9:30 am and after 4:00 pm. We provide traffic cones on Oak and 8th Streets for traffic control and safety. Parking is at a premium in the morning and

There is no parking on the park blocks for members. There is a 20-minute loading/ unloading limit at the park blocks. After unloading your vehicle, please park your vehicle promptly and then come back to set up your booth.

To ensure safety and deliberately organized system of loading/unloading on Saturday, we must insist you adhere to this policy. Violations can result in disciplinary action. Thanks, and enjoy being with us at the Saturday Market.

### From The Board

The Eugene Saturday Market Board of Directors would like to extend a formal apology to our General Manager, Shannon Lee-Hutson, for the situation that led to her termination on March 26th, 2025. The process under which this termination took place violated our policies and procedures. It also put our organization at financial risk due to negligent employment practices. In normal circumstances the Market's board consists of nine members. This hasty termination, made by a six member board, was based on unproven accusations without any relevant well researched evidence presented to the board. No time was given for fact finding and our

No time was given for fact finding and our policy processes were ignored. Shannon was rehired by the Board of Directors on April 2nd, 2025 because she is qualified for the job. She displayed that in her performance the previous two years as the Market's general manager. Shannon has steadily improved her skill sets and is a competent manager both operationally and in her fiduciary responsibilities to the organization. It is the opinion of the Board that the Market is fortunate to have such a competent and committed general manager.
