### **Elf Game**

It's time to take a moment to introduce &/or re-introduce the Elf Game to you. Many are already familiar with this longrunning "game" of sorts, some have heard about it & wondered how & what? & guite a few are new to the HM & haven't heard anything yet. Think of the Elf Game as a scavenger hunt for our customers. Elf Hunters get a game card from an Info Booth or Elf Station that includes pictures of the elves along with small clues about each one's environment or hobby...(think "soap maker has an elf that like to blow bubbles") Elf Hunters explore the HM and look at all the booths for the "hidden" elf (most members place the elf somewhere tucked, but visible from the aisle).

When they locate an elf, the hunter writes down the booth number. If an Elf Hunter finds at least 6 Elves, they can collect a prize from one of the Info Booths or Elf Stations. The prizes are stickers, buttons, magnets, & temporary tattoos made from the images on our beautiful HM Poster. If an Elf Hunter wants to find 12 or more elves, they can get a prize & be entered in a drawing to win a Gift Card to spend at HM! Kids young & old (& quite a few adults too), love to participate. The game encourages visitors to explore & discover across the entire market, & brings them near booths they might not have wandered near otherwise. Since some market members are only at HM one of those two weekends, it brings dedicated hunters that want to "find them all", back for another visit for the elves that were missed!
